## Complete Your Requirements to Maintain Your Certification

Dear Dr.

Thank you for participating in ABIM's Maintenance of Certification (MOC) program. We are reaching out to you to let you know that the MOC program changes are now in effect.

All ABIM Board Certified physicians with a current and valid license will remain certified until the end date of each time-limited certification they hold. In addition, ABIM will begin reporting if you are "Meeting MOC Requirements."

You are currently "Meeting MOC Requirements." However, please note that if you wish to maintain your certification in Pulmonary Disease, you will need to complete your current requirements by the end of this year.

### What should you do now?

- Log in to check your MOC Status Report, which tells you what you need to do and when.
  - You may be prompted to choose the certification(s) you are maintaining, if you have not already done so.
- If you have not yet passed your Pulmonary Disease MOC exam and are going to maintain this certification, note that you can take the exam in the spring or fall this year. However, if you wish to take the exam in the spring and have not yet scheduled, you must schedule your exam by February 28.
- You also have access to all ABIM modules at no additional cost. These modules offer you an opportunity to earn MOC points and CME.
